Mayor Bradley called the work session to order and asked the clerk for a roll call. The clerk called the roll and the above listed persons were present.

St. Clair County Road Commissioner Ricky Parker and Engineer Dan Dahlke were present for the work session meeting.


The Council discussed the road contract with the County and potentially halting anymore work on the roads. The County would be paid for any current progress.

There was general conversation on Argo Parkway/ Liles Lane. The road is in poor condition and the State and County are denying responsibility. The Council discussed all the steps the City had taken to get the issue resolved, including applying for grants and being unsuccessful. Commissioner Parker stated they would not be responsible for fixing the road, it would be up to the City. The City does not have the funds to maintain a busy thoroughfare such as Argo Parkway. The Council inquired how much it would cost to pave that strip of road. Dan Dahlke stated he would provide the City with a general estimate. Springville Mayor Butch Isley and Senator Jim McClendon were present in the audience and stated they were in support of Argo. This issue was of public interest to all surrounding Municipalities and they would do all they could to assist. Senator McClendon stated he would contact Mr. Cooper with ALDOT the following day. Attorney Jeff Sherrer stated he would also investigate further with the State since the State had been maintaining that portion of road in previous years.
