ROLL CALL

Mayor Bradley called the meeting to order and asked the clerk for a roll call. The clerk called the roll and the above listed persons were present.

Councilperson Brown gave the invocation.

Mayor Bradley opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilperson Massey called tonight's meeting for the discussion and viewing of the roads. The estimate that was given was \$387,805.72, the approved budget was \$325k. Councilperson Massey proposed cutting the list and doing the worst ones and most traveled first, then possibly going in order of the remainder of the list or the necessity of the road.

Mayor Bradley asked which roads were intended to be first, Freeze Mtn/Masters, and Cedar Creek, are the ones that have to most traffic. She also asked if this would be complete paving of these roads and not patching, Massey assured the council this would be a complete road paving project.

Councilperson Massey made the motion to ride the roads and come back for further review.

Councilperson Brown seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Cowan-yea, Massey-yea, Alldredge-late, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Mayor Pro-Tem Alldredge was present for the remainder of the meeting, after the council returned from the ride around.

Councilperson Massey proposed possibly looking at adding additional roads to the current list, Mayor Bradley agreed the discussed roads needed work, but the roads already on the list should be completed first, before adding anymore roads to this list.

Discussion was held on which roads needed the work first.

Councilperson Cowan suggested taking \$100k from the 610 account, and \$100k from the road funds totaling \$200k for Freeze Mtn/Masters and Cedar Creek Rd. Leaving \$184k in the road funds in case of emergencies, and \$95,837.97 in Capital Improvement for the building, originally from the 610 account.

Councilperson Massey asked everyone to ride out and look at Rocky Ridge Road and In Tha Woods. He wants to make sure everyone knows it will not be the entire road, In Tha Woods will start where the curbs end, to the first intersection. He asks everyone to have an open mind about the roads and he would like for a decision to be made at the next council meeting


Councilperson Massey motioned to adjourn. Mayor Pro-Tem Alldredge seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.
