Mayor Bradley called the meeting to order and asked the clerk for a roll call. The clerk called the roll, and the above listed persons were present.

Invocation was given by Glenn Waldrop, and the pledge of allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

Councilperson Brown motioned to approve the minutes from the meetings dated 04-26-21 with one wording change, and 05-10-21 including the work session with no changes. Councilperson Hicks seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Hicks-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Councilperson Brown motioned to table the Bid process for city trash collection. Councilperson McCarley seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Hicks-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Councilperson Brown motioned to postpone the vote on the FEMA flood plain resolution until the June 28th council meeting. Mayor Pro-tem Stinson seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Hicks-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Councilperson Hicks motioned to approve the DEU MOU with St. Clair county. Councilperson Brown seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Hicks-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Councilperson Hicks motioned to approve funding of the DEU MOU with St. Clair county from the general fund account. Councilperson McCarley seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Hicks-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Mayor Pro-tem Stinson motioned to approve the proposed engineered septic system for 8885 Hwy 11 with \$4100 for system design and \$36,000 for installation, to be paid from the capital improvement fund. Councilperson Hicks seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Hicks-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Councilperson Brown motioned to approve the use of city hall by Argo business alliance meeting June 4th at 0730. Mayor Pro-tem Stinson seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Hicks-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Councilperson Hicks motioned to approve striping of the city hall parking areas using the current traffic pattern. Mayor Pro-tem Stinson seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Hicks-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-no, Brown-no, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

CITY ATTORNEY – No new business.

MAYOR REPORT – The Mayor reminded the council members of the Regional Planning Committee presentation scheduled for June 14.

Councilperson Brown noted that all required funding for the disc golf course had been received. With materials and invoicing to arrive by June 10th. This did not include the large course overview map.

A motion was made to adjourn. All in favor. Meeting adjourned.
