Mayor Bradley called the meeting to order and asked the clerk for a roll call. The clerk called the roll, and the above listed persons were present.

Invocation was given by Mayor Pro-Tem Stinson, and the pledge of allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

Councilperson Brown motioned to approve the work session minutes and regular meeting minutes as presented from 02/14/2022. Mayor Pro-Tem Stinson seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

David Cork and Joe Chapman, with Cork, Hill & Company, LLC, presented the mayor and council with a brief synopsis of the City's Audit for fiscal year 2020-2021. Every member of the council was given a hard copy of the audit for their reference. Overall, the city is doing well.

Chief Scott Payne presented Brent Rejonis and Hunter Songer with their red helmets as they have both are being promoted to Lieutenant. He briefly explained how the hiring process went, since there were 3 qualified applicants and only 2 positions available. Chief also gave a brief update on the truck its new expected delivery date is April 20<sup>th</sup>, and the fire bay doors are due to be installed mid-late April.

Councilperson Griffin motioned to nominate Councilperson McCarley as Voting Delegate for ALM and Mayor Pro-Tem Stinson as 1<sup>st</sup> alternate. Councilperson Brown seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Mayor Pro-Tem Stinson motioned to approve Resolution 2022-02-28, A Resolution Authorizing the Use of American Rescue Plan Act (Arpa) Funds Received Under the Standard Allowance Provision for Lost Revenue Under 31 C.F.R. § 35. Councilperson Brown seconded the motion.

Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Councilperson Brown motioned to approve Ordinance 2022-02-28A, An Ordinance of The City of Argo, Alabama, To Protect the Health, Safety, And General Welfare of Its Citizens and Businesses Relating to Subdivision Regulations and Declaring a Moratorium on The Filing of Subdivision Applications Within the Corporate Limits of The City of Argo, Alabama. Councilperson McCarley seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Mayor Bradley spoke with the council about changing the following council meeting to Wednesday March 16<sup>th</sup> due to several conflicts earlier in the week. Mayor Pro-Tem motioned to suspend the rules to add this to the agenda. Councilperson Brown seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Mayor Pro-Tem motioned to change the March 14<sup>th</sup> council meeting to Wednesday March 16<sup>th</sup>. Councilperson Brown seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

**MAYOR REPORT** – Mayor Bradley reminded every one of the zoning meeting scheduled for tomorrow, March 1<sup>st</sup> at 6pm here at city hall. She also spoke to the council regarding hosting a meet and greet for the local candidates in St. Clair County. She and the council agreed on Tuesday April 12<sup>th</sup> at 6pm.
