Mayor Bradley called the meeting to order and asked the clerk for a roll call. The clerk called the roll, and the above listed persons were present.

Invocation was given by Tommy Suggs, and the pledge of allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

Councilperson Brown motioned to approve the work session minutes and regular meeting minutes as presented from 01/10/2022. Councilperson McCarley seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yea, Hicks-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Councilperson Hicks motioned to approve Ordinance 2022-01-24, An Ordinance Declaring Certain Property Owned by The City of Argo, Alabama, As Surplus and Authorizing its Disposition. Councilperson Griffin seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yea, Hicks-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

The floor was opened for discussion on item #7 on the agenda, there were no objections, public hearing was closed. Councilperson Brown motioned approve Ordinance No 2022-01-24A, An Ordinance Approving of The Replat of Deer Creek Subdivision and The Creation of Ridgeview Phase 1, A New Subdivision. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yea, Hicks-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-abstain. Motion carried.

Mayor Bradley's reasoning for abstention is her husband has done work for Mr. Arant.

Councilperson Hicks motioned to approve the paying of the city's Municipal Workers Compensation Insurance, in the amount of \$49,767.00. Councilperson Brown seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yea, Hicks-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.


CITY ATTORNEY – No new business.
