Mayor Bradley called the meeting to order and asked the clerk for a roll call. The clerk called the roll, and the above listed persons were present.

Invocation was given by Mr. Bob Carter, and the pledge of allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

Councilperson McCarley motioned to approve the work session minutes and regular meeting minutes as presented from 04/11/2022. Councilperson Brown seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yea, Hicks-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Councilperson Hicks motioned to approve the City of Argo to apply for the Alabama Tourism Grant. Councilperson Griffin seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yea, Hicks-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Mr. Paul Jennings asked to speak at tonight's meeting to discuss the possibility of the city placing a splashpad at or around the park for the children to enjoy during the summer months. He made several valid points, but the council did have some concerns such as where to place it, who would man it, and liability concerns. Councilperson Brown did say it is definitely an idea worth looking into.

Mayor Pro-Tem Stinson motioned to approve the difference of \$1823.50 for the purchase of the dump trailer from Terry Sligh Automotive with the ARPA funds. Councilperson Griffin seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yea, Hicks-yea, Stinson-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.
