Mayor Bradley called the meeting to order and asked the clerk for a roll call. The clerk called the roll, and the above listed persons were present.

Invocation was given by Councilperson Brown, and the pledge of allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

FIRE REPORT – Chief Scott Payne gave the monthly fire report. The fire department had a total of 68 calls for the month of December, issued 8 burn permits, 40 medical calls, 4 MVC's, 14 assists.

POLICE REPORT – Chief Alan Busler gave the monthly police report, they had 232 dispatched for the month of December, 6 felony arrests, 7 misdemeanor arrests, 6 K-9 calls, resulting in 5 arrests, 34 response calls on I-59, 11 animal complaints, 63-911 calls.

Councilperson Brown motioned to approve the Regular meeting minutes and Work Session minutes from 12/12/2022, 12/19/2022 and minutes from the Special Called meeting from 1/3/2023. Councilperson McCarley seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yea, Suggs-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Former Police Chief Glenn Wells and Chief Alan Busler presented the 2nd Annual Officer of the Year Award to K-9 officer Cason Davis. Both Wells and Busler talked about how well deserving Officer Davis is of this award, from his revamping of the evidence room to his always having a positive attitude at work.

Councilperson Brown motioned to approve the Paving Bond Agreement presented. Councilperson Griffin seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-

yea, Suggs-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

MAYOR REPORT –Mayor Bradley reminded everyone that City Hall will be closed Monday January 16th, for Martin Luther King Day. She also briefly talked about the zoning classes, she is in discussion with Corey about group rate pricing and dates and will update everyone once she knows more. The city received the bill for its workers comp insurance premium, the price dropped since last year. She also wanted to remind everyone of the swearing in ceremony for Sheriff Billy Murray will be Tuesday January 17th at 10AM. She also received a thank you letter from Mrs. Tucker for the flowers the city sent for Mr. Tucker.

CITY ATTORNEY –No new business.


A motion was made to adjourn. All in favor. Meeting adjourned.
