ROLL CALL

Mayor Bradley called the meeting to order and asked the clerk for a roll call. The clerk called the roll, and the roll call is listed above.

The invocation was given by Councilperson Rick Hopkins, and the pledge of allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

Mayor Pro-Tem Brown motioned to approve the Regular meeting minutes and Work Session minutes from 6/26/2023. Councilperson McCarley seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: McCarley-yea, Hopkins-abstain, Brown-yea and Mayor Bradley-yea. Motion carried.

Councilperson Hopkins made the motion for Resolution 2023-07-10 to provide one-time funds to the Employees' Retirement System under Alabama Section 1 of Act #2023-10. Mayor Pro-Tem Brown seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Hopkins-yea, McCarley-yea, Brown-yea, Mayor Bradley-yea.

FIRE REPORT – Chief Payne gave the monthly fire report noting that Argo FD responded to 53 calls in June. He also reported that donations from the community and citizens are coming in.

POLICE REPORT – Police Chief Alan Busler gave the monthly Police Report. There was a total of 276 dispatched calls including 26 arrests, 7 motor vehicle accidents, 10 Residential alarms, 5 DV calls, and 2 animal complaints.

MAYORS REPORT - Mayor Betty Bradley reminded everyone that the city has placed ads and is accepting bids for roofing city hall.

Mayor asked the council to consider a car for the new building inspector.

Mayor updated the council on maintenance work. One city tractor is working well and the city's maintenance worker has been cutting grass with it. The other tractor is out for repairs.

Mayor reported that AMIC insurance is increasing and the city should consider shopping around for new insurance.

CITY COUNCIL – Mayor Pro-Tem Brown proposed August 8th for hosting the Mayor's Breakfast.

CITY ATTORNEY- No new business.

PUBLIC COMMENTS - No public comments.
