

Mayor Bradley called the meeting to order and asked for a roll call. Roll was called and the roll call is listed above.

The invocation was given by Councilperson Hopkins and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

County Commissioner Candidates Tommy Bowers and Bob Mize cancelled and were not present to speak.

Mayor Pro-Tem Brown made a motion to suspend the rules to add item to the agenda: setting the application fee at \$75 for Zoning Variance requests. Councilperson Griffin seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yes, Suggs-yes, Hopkins-yes, McCarley-yes, Brown-yes. Bradley-yes. Motion carried.

Mayor Pro-Tem Brown made a motion to approve the setting of a \$75 application fee for Zoning Variance requests. Councilperson Griffin seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yes, Suggs-yes, Hopkins-yes, McCarley-yes, Brown-yes. Bradley-yes. Motion carried.

MAYOR REPORT – Mayor Bradley announced that the St. Clair County Commission sent the City \$100,000 of the gas tax money for road repairs.

A report on the work being done on Mary Ann Lane was given.

Roulain Road will be repaired when the weather gets better. They can't do the needed repairs when the weather is as cold as it has been.

Mayor Bradley thanked Attorney David Moore for the donation of a new conference table. The City will be using it in the training room in City Hall.

Mayor Bradley thanked the police, fire, and maintenance departments for helping out during the winter weather. All departments worked together to sand the roads, to open the storm shelter as a warming shelter, and to keep the city safe.

CITY ATTORNEY – no new business.

CITY COUNCIL – Mayor Pro-tem Brown thanked the Mayor for sending flowers for Randy Melvin’s service. Karen Melvin has been on the board of directors for the Argo Community Food Bank.

OFFICER OF THE YEAR AWARD – Chief Busler was present to give the Officer of the Year Award to Officer Jason Mitchell. Officer Mitchell was sent to the Police Academy by Argo and the first officer to fulfill their obligations to the City in return for Police Academy training.

PUBLIC COMMENTS – No public comments.

A motion was made to adjourn. All in favor. Meeting adjourned.
