Councilperson McCarley made a motion to approve GFL Environmental garbage service 3% increase. Councilperson Hopkins seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Suggs-yes, Hopkins-yes, McCarley-yes, Brown-yes. Bradley-yes. Motion carried.

Mayor Pro-Tem Brown made a motion to approve the quote for mulch for the park, from Rubber Mulch Warehouse in the amount of \$4235.00, with the money to come out of the Capital

Improvement Fund. Councilperson Hopkins seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Suggs-yes, Hopkins-yes, McCarley-yes, Brown-yes. Bradley-yes. Motion carried.

MAYOR REPORT — Mayor Bradley updated the council on repairs to the water heater at City Hall. The current water heater can't be repaired. Quotes will be obtained for a new one and will be approved by the council at that time.
