Mayor Bradley called the meeting to order and asked for a roll call. Roll was called and the roll call is listed above.

The invocation was given by Councilperson Hopkins and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

**POLICE REPORT** – Chief Busler gave the Police Report for March. He was happy to announce that two offices have graduated from FTO school. APD had a total of 620 calls for March which included 233 traffic stops and 17 wrecks.

**FIRE REPORT** – Chief Payne gave the monthly fire report. Argo FD had a total of 40 calls in March. Chief Payne also discussed the need to surplus a piece of equipment. The Fire Department already has a buyer lined up for it, pending council approval.

Councilperson Hopkins made a motion to approve the Fire Department Surplus of Equipment: Air System MAKO AC10SE1 with serial number 540541902. Councilperson McCarley seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yes, Suggs-yes, Hopkins-yes, McCarley-yes, Bradley-yes. Motion carried.

Councilperson McCarley made a motion to accept the resignation of City Clerk Tommie Ebner. Councilperson Hopkins seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yes, Suggs-yes, Hopkins-yes, McCarley-yes, Bradley-yes. Motion carried.

Councilperson Griffin made a motion to approve the bill for emergency repairs to the generator that powers the storm shelter. The repairs totaled \$450 from Auxiliary Power Systems. Councilperson Suggs seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yes, Suggs-yes, Hopkins-yes, McCarley-yes, Bradley-yes. Motion carried.

Councilperson Hopkins made a motion to approve the invoice from G&A Electrical for work

done in the fire station in the amount of \$775. Councilperson Suggs seconded the motion. Mayor Bradley called for roll call of votes: Griffin-yes, Suggs-yes, Hopkins-yes, McCarley-yes, Bradley-yes. Motion carried.
