The City Council for the City of Argo met on Monday, June 9, 2025, for a work session. The meeting was held at the Municipal Complex located at 100 Blackjack Road, Argo, AL 35173.

The work session consisted of discussion on June 9, 2025, regular council meeting agenda.

The Mayor and Council reviewed the cyber insurance quote and decided to obtain additional quotes for comparison. The matter will be reviewed again at the June 23, 2025, meeting.

The Mayor and Council agreed that City-Wide Cleanup Day will be held on June 21, 2025, and will focus on cleaning up the sides of the roads. Trash collected during the event will be placed in the dumpster at City Hall. Citizen Corkey Massey offered the use of his personal dumpster if the City Hall dumpster becomes full. Citizen Michelle Coalson informed the Mayor and Council that she has garbage bags, gloves, and grabbers available for the event.

Citizen Corkey Massey provided the Mayor and Council with an update on the property intended for a future storm shelter. He also stated that St. Clair County may be able to assist with the dirt work.

Councilperson Hopkins noted that the City of Argo may be a good candidate for an upcoming grant cycle. He stated that grants are awarded for up to \$70,000 and requested guidance from the Mayor and Council on potential project ideas to pursue.

Mayor Pro Tem Brown requested that the agenda include consideration of a \$250.00 donation to purchase books for the Book Nook located in the city park.
