
Councilperson Griffin will report on the Argo Business Alliance at the next meeting.


City Attorney Chesley reviewed **Ordinance No. 2026-01-26 (310) An Ordinance Respecting the Use of the Public Rights-Of-Way in the City of Argo, Alabama by Southern Light, LLC.** for a fiber franchise, noting that it is a 10-year franchise allowing the use of the right-of-way with a 5% user fee. He stated that Southlight will be responsible for any damage that may occur and recommended that the City obtain contact information for all subcontractors in accordance with the ordinance.

Fire Chief Scott Payne recognized Lt. Ryan Wells as Firefighter of the Year. Lt. Wells has 24 years of experience and assists with truck maintenance and EMS supplies.
