Work Session

The City Council for the City of Argo met on Monday, February 9, 2026, for a work session. The meeting was held at the Municipal Complex located at 100 Blackjack Road, Argo, AL 35173.

The work session consisted of discussion on February 9, 2026, regular council meeting agenda.

Mayor Hettich informed the Council that the Liles Lane repair project, which was originally expected to begin in the first quarter, is now anticipated to start around April or May.

Mayor Randy Hettich updated the Council ongoing efforts to obtain a ZIP Code for the City of Argo. A letter has been sent to Congressman Mike Rogers' office. The request has been forwarded appropriately, and the Mayor will update the Council as soon as additional information is received.

The Mayor and Council agreed to place Former Mayor Bradley's plaque inside the storm shelter. A ribbon cutting ceremony will be held; however, no date has been set at this time.


Mayor Hettich and the Council discussed renting the training room and kitchen to residents of Argo. The proposed rental fee would be \$100.00, with a \$50.00 refundable deposit required. The facility would be available for events such as teas, showers, and senior gatherings. Rentals would be scheduled in two-hour blocks.

The Mayor informed the Council that the Municipal Judge, Prosecutor, and Public Defender have requested salary increases. The Mayor and Council discussed the requested raises and possible adjustments.

The Mayor and Council discussed donating \$500.00 to the St. Clair County Education Foundation.

City Attorney Chesley Payne will review the bylaws for the Junior Council. The bylaws will be presented for approval at the Council meeting.
